QUALIFIED MOTOR VEHICLE (QMV) - A motor vehicle used, designed, or maintained for transportation of persons or property which:

- Has two axles and a gross vehicle weight or registered gross vehicle weight exceeding 26,000 pounds; or
- Has three or more axles regardless of weight;
- \* Is used in combination, when the weight of such combination exceeds 26,000 pounds gross or registered gross vehicle weight.

"Qualified Motor Vehicle" does not include recreational or Federal (U.S. Government) vehicles.

RECORD KEEPING INFORMATION - It is your responsibility to keep and maintain acceptable mileage records for all interstate and intrastate apportionable or QMV movement. You must also retain fuel receipts (Invoices, bulk fuel use) to substantiate your fuel use reporting. Mileage records must contain the beginning and ending odometer or hubodometer readings and the complete route of travel. Fuel tax records must be kept for 4 years. International Registration Plan (IRP) mileage records must be kept for 5 1/2 years. For more information on audit, call (608) 264-7239.
